## • Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities (www.ccdisabilities.nic.in)

The Office of the Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities has been set up under Section 57 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights & Full Participation) Act, 1995. The objective is to safeguard the rights of persons with disabilities.

Activities:

- a) Creation of awareness adopting preventive measures..
- b) Taking up with concerned authorities to implement inclusive education for children with disabilities and availability of required facilities.
- c) Taking up with concerned organisations to ensure 3% reservation for person with disabilities on receipt of complaints
- d) Taking measures to identify posts suitable for persons with disabilities.
- e) Non Discrimination in favour of disabled persons.
- f) Implementation of the Persons with Disabilities Act, 1995
- g) Taking up matters with various Ministries for formulation of schemes for the benefit of persons with disabilities, coordination of the work of Commissioners by organisation national level and regional meetings of the State Commissioners to review status of implementation of the provisions of the Act.
